- * Persecuted Christians www.persecution.com India: In Andhra Pradesh state, officials are conducting a survey to identify all Christians who have come from Hindu families, married a Hindu or are conducting Christian activities. Such surveys have generally led to increased persecution and discrimination. Front-line workers ask for prayer for Christians in India as violence against Christians grows and is expected to increase even more as the 2023 national elections approach.

 Amat in India: They are also known as the Amanat. They are mostly farmers; though some are artists, day laborers or carpenters. They speak Oriya, which is the language of Odisha, their home state. They place themselves higher in the caste system than others would. They consider themselves to be Sudras, the fourth and lowest of caste clusters. Others would consider them to be so low as to be outside the caste system. Their spiritual lives are crippled by astrology, which they believe determines their destiny. Pray that Holy Spiritled Christian believers would go to the Amat people. They can demonstrate the power and love of the Savior. Pray that the Lord Jesus would raise up a vibrant, worshiping church and a disciple making movement among this people.
