

- * Persecuted Christians www.persecution.com. Niger: Christians are using motorcycles and audio Bibles to bring the gospel to people living in the desert. Only 35% of the population is literate, so audio Bibles are a particularly effective ministry tool. One Christian worker recently reported that after hearing a gospel presentation and receiving audio Bibles in their native language, an entire family of fourteen people living in an isolated, outlying area gave their lives to Christ. Pray for the family to grow in faith, that more families in Niger will be receptive to the gospel, and for safety for him and other ministers as they drive their motorcycles through the desert.
- * Unreached People https://joshuaproject.net/pray/unreachedoftheday-Azeri in Belarus: The homeland of the Azerbaijani (also known as the Azeris) has been the target of numerous invasions throughout history. Their culture is a blend of Turkic and Persian influences. A small number of Azeri live in Belarus. They are unwilling to heed the words of Jesus Christ regarding salvation by faith alone. Many Azeris identify as cultural Muslims. Islam is their heritage, but it does not offer hope, peace or the promise of eternal life. They need to be introduced to the God who loves them and who sent to his only son to save them. As far as we know, there are no Christian believers among this people in Belarus. Pray for dedicated, Holy Spirit-anointed workers to go to the Azeris in Belarus. Pray for the Holy Spirit to move among Azeri family heads, so they will be willing to listen to the gospel.
- * 2023 World Watch List (most dangerous countries for Christians) #5-Libya: Prayer Points: Pray for nationwide stability, law and order to come quickly to Libya. Pray that God would break the power of the organized criminal gangs exploiting vulnerable people.
