Mark & Rebecca Bueckert, Ryley, AB...located in North Central Alberta, about an hour's drive east of Edmonton. Our church celebrated 44 years with VM this November. We've served in this field for 15 years, seeing many changes in the culture of the community. Ryley was

founded as an agricultural community, and many still work the land. But the community is now more of a community and with people working in the oil patch. Locally we have a coal mine and two huge waste transfer stations that employ nearly a hundred people. Like most small communities, we face increasing struggles with crime, drugs, and poverty. - * Persecuted Christians www.persecution.com. Benin: This is considered the birthplace of Voodoo. Occult practices, including idol worship, sacrificing animals, and wearing special talismans believed to ward off evil, are widespread. Voodoo is so commonly practiced in Benin that it has a National Voodoo Day on January 10. This year in a small town in the center of the country, a group of Voodooists burned down a church when local Christians refused to honor the village idols during the celebration. The church's pastor asks for prayer that people in the village will be set free from the bondage of Voodoo, that the house of worship will be rebuilt, and that the congregation will be strengthened regardless of persecution.
- * Unreached People https://joshuaproject.net/pray/unreachedoftheday- Aguri in India: They are a cultivating and trading caste, mostly located in West Bengal and concentrated in Anguna. They have two castes. The upper caste consists of agricultural land owners and lower caste members who work on farms as laborers and cowherders. They only know about Hinduism and believe that by performing rituals and good works, they will attain freedom from the endless cycle of birth, death and rebirth. Their basic needs are education, medical facilities and water wells. The Aguri have a spiritual hunger for knowing the truth. Through screenings of the JESUS Film, hundreds have accepted Jesus Christ as their Savior. Pray for better access to God's Word. Pray for improved schools, roads, water and medicine. Pray that believers would reach out and begin a disciple making movement.
- * 2023 World Watch List (most dangerous countries for Christians) #11 India: Prayer Points: Pray for a change of narrative around Indian identity that accepts minority faiths. Pray that converts' genuine faith would have a powerful effect on their families and neighbours.
