\* Persecuted Christians - www.persecution.com- Central African Republic:

Christians have suffered greatly from civil war in the CAR since 2012. They are targeted and attacked by Muslim rebels who accuse them of assisting militias that have carried out revenge killings against Muslims. They have been driven from their towns and villages as attackers loot and destroy their homes and churches, forcing tens of thousands into emergency camps for Internally Displaced Peoples. A Christian man who cares for 58 orphans told of how insurgents targeted him with accusations, threats and assaults because of his ministry. Once, an attacker put a machine gun into the Christian man's face and pulled the trigger; nothing happened. The attacker then shot the weapon in the air and tried a second time to shoot the Christian man in the head; again, the gun failed. The attacker then beat the orphanage director, breaking his front teeth.

\* Unreached People - <a href="https://joshuaproject.net/pray/unreachedoftheday/today-Waigeli Nuristani">https://joshuaproject.net/pray/unreachedoftheday/today-Waigeli Nuristani in Afghanistan:</a> The Nuristani people are unique living in northeast Afghanistan. Critical infrastructure and services do not exist to aid them, leaving Nuristan as one of Afghanistan's most impoverished areas. They have a historical distrust of outsiders, a determined independence, in-fighting and a lingering fear of spiritual consequences. They are loyal Sunni Muslims who believe that following religious routine determines the afterlife. They believe spirits also determine how well they live in daily life. Current needs: Communication is difficult due to remoteness, topography and even inclement weather, healthcare is virtually non-existent, and schools are few. The need for roads to bring access for aid and development projects, as well as to bring in food and supplies, remains urgent. Pray they would see they do not have to live in slavery to spirits if they put their trust in Jesus Christ. Pray that a movement to Christ would propel a church planting movement that will thrive and bring shalom to their communities.

\*2023 World Watch List (most dangerous countries for Christians) #16-China: Prayer Points: Pray that Christians facing the burden of surveillance will be given strength, wisdom and boldness as they navigate challenges. Pray that young people who've not previously experienced persecution will be equipped to stand strong in their faith.
