### Pray for:

- \* Persecuted Christians <a href="www.persecution.com">www.persecution.com</a>- Morocco: Only a fraction of 1 percent of the population of Morocco are Christians, and lack of access to Bibles limits the growth of Christian communities. "Believers and seekers in this country face a shortage of physical Bibles and are usually obligated to interact with God's Word in an online or digital format, which is not accessible for everyone," a worker recently said. Additionally, new followers of Christ are often threatened by family members, discriminated against by landlords, and forced to relocate unexpectedly. The worker requested prayer that governmental restrictions on Bibles and Christian materials be removed, for unity among believers, and for persecuted Christians in the country to grow through persecution and experience joy in suffering.
- \* Unreached People -https://joshuaproject.net/pray/unreachedoftheday/todayOrochi in Ukraine: The Orochi are among the peoples groups in Russia's far east.
  They come from a land where few can live, so most have moved to Ukraine and other parts of Russia where they can make a living. They are in the process of adapting to a far different culture than they had in eastern Russia. They are Buddhist, shamanistic or marginally Russian Orthodox. Their state of spiritual confusion might be a barrier to accepting the lordship of Jesus Christ. Some have become marginal Christians in Russia. Few, if any, have embraced Jesus in Ukraine. Pray for spiritual hunger to permeate Orochi society, giving them the desire and ability to follow Jesus. Pray for right workers to be sent to these people who desperately need a Savior.
- \* 2023 World Watch List (most dangerous countries for Christians) #38 Mexico:

  Pray for a return to law and order in the parts of Mexico where crime currently reigns.

  Pray for God's wisdom and power for Christians standing up to the criminal gangs in their areas.
