* **Persecuted Christians** - www.persecution.com- **Nepal:** A 10-year-old boy who has been regularly attending a children's fellowship for the last year, received a children's Bible during a distribution event. His mother was attracted by the colorful pictures and began to read the Bible herself. Through this Bible, both mother and son came to know Jesus Christ as their Savior. They, along with three other children who received Bibles, publicly committed their lives to the Lord on September 16, 2023.

* **Unreached People** - <https://joshuaproject.net/pray/unreachedoftheday/today>- **Tseku in China:** The Tseku people live in the high, remote Himalayan Mountains. They live in freezing, blizzard-like weather. They either adapt to the climate or they perish. Their food is mainly meat and milk from their livestock together with barley and rice. Since their language is similar to the Kham Tibetans, they are often mistaken for members of that larger people group. Few, if any, Christian workers are willing to live in such a remote, inhospitable land. Tibetan Buddhism is also a major spiritual obstacle. There are believers in China who are trying to take the gospel to this group and others like them. May the widows and orphans among this people group become part of God's family. There are no believers among the Tseku people in Bhutan and a very small number in China. Pray for the Lord to bring about a movement to Christ among them. Pray for the Holy Spirit to give the Tseku people teachable and understanding hearts.

* **2024 World Watch List** (most dangerous countries for Christians): **#14 - Mali:** Pray for courage and safety for Christians living at risk of attack from Islamic militants. Pray for those affected by persecution to have a profound experience of God's comfort. Pray that elections will go ahead this year, leading to stronger, just governance in Mali.
