* **Persecuted Christians** - www.persecution.com - **Bhutan:** Christians in Bhutan often risk losing their citizenship or other rights because of their faith in Christ. Pastor Abhaya and his wife have been denied a marriage certificate by the government, which jeopardizes their whole family, especially their children, who have been denied citizenship. The family may have to relocate to another country for the sake of their children. Pray for this family as they make decisions related to their future and the church he leads. Pray that Christian families in Bhutan will be able to meet the needs of their families despite this kind of pressure.

* **Unreached People** - <https://joshuaproject.net/pray/unreachedoftheday/today> - **Danish Jewish in Denmark:** During World War II, many of the Jews in Denmark were evacuated to Sweden, where they managed to survive the Holocaust. They were not fully accepted into Danish society until recent years. Today, most are well educated and speak Danish, along with other European languages. The majority live in the cities of Copenhagen and Aarhus. Like the rest of European culture, younger Jews are becoming increasingly secular. They value education and career advancement while conservative Jews continue to resist being assimilated. Because many Jews have a basic understanding of God and his laws, sharing the truth that they have broken his commands and failed to live up to his standards could bring conviction. Without the sacrificial system to provide forgiveness, they desperately need the only savior. Ask God to open their eyes, hearts and ears to the good news of their Messiah.

* **2024 World Watch List** (most dangerous countries for Christians): # 18 - **Myanmar:** Pray that secret believers will be able to access the Bible in their own language this year. Pray that our family in the Maldives will draw huge encouragement from knowing they are part of a global family who stand with them in prayer. Pray that the forthcoming presidential term will mark a softening towards religious minorities, including Christians.
