Persecuted Christians - www.persecution.com - Ethiopia:

While Ethiopia is a majority-Christian nation, Islam is a growing force. Muslims now compose nearly 40 percent of the population, and Islamic extremists actively persecute Christians, sometimes violently. Sometimes the extremists destroy churches, and they recently set fire to one located in the far western part of the country near the border with Sudan. *"Now the Christians in that area don't have a place to meet for worship,"* said a front-line worker. Numerous churches have been destroyed in that area, but the worker reported that VOM has helped rebuild many of those churches. He requested prayer for the congregations who have suffered in that region: *"Please pray for the Christians to stand firm and preach the gospel."*

Abu-Junuk in Sudan: The Abu-Junuk people group live in a subdistrict by the same name in the northwest section of the State of South Kordofan, Sudan. Farming sorghum and a few other crops, they raise goats, sheep, and cattle. Remarkably, they have three primary schools and two secondary schools. The Abu-Junuk people are Sunni Muslim. In their drought ridden environment, they collect rainwater and draw water from a few wells. There is still a lack of safe drinking water. Pray for the Holy Spirit to move mightily among this people group. Pray for loving workers to be thrust out among them. Pray there will soon come a day when these Muslims will disciple others in the ways of Christ.

*** 2024 World Watch List** (most dangerous countries for Christians): # 21 - **Laos:** Pray for Christians and church leaders who are heavily monitored by the communist government. Ask God to give them wisdom and courage. Pray that God will comfort believers who are expelled from their communities for their faith. Ask God to protect unregistered churches.
