

- *Persecuted Christians www.persecution.com- Kenya: Hussein finds strength in community with other Christians after familial rejection for his faith. Hussein came to faith in Christ 20 years ago after experiencing him in a dream and was soon baptized. Since then, Hussein has faced opposition for his Christian faith. He was kicked out of his village, his property was taken from him and his wife left him. He has also been ridiculed by his family and isolated from his children, all of which negatively impacted Hussein's wellbeing. "The rejection and discrimination Hussein went through resulted in some level of trauma and depression in his life," his pastor said. However, Hussein has remained strong in faith. He regularly visits churches throughout Kenya to share his testimony, and fellowship with other Christians helps when he experiences loneliness. Still, the pastor requested prayer for Hussein, who desires to a have a permanent, stable home with his family.
- * Unreached People https://joshuaproject.net/pray/unreachedoftheday/today- Odienne Jula in Côte d'Ivoire: The Jula (or Dyula) are skilled craftsmen and merchants. One Jula subgroup is the Odienne, the name of a town in northwestern Côte d'Ivoire with its own airport. This has long been a trading center. The Jula peoples are fiercely loyal to their clans. A movement to Christ might need to happen at the clan level. They maintain their cultural history through the oral traditions of dance and storytelling, which are probably best for presenting the gospel as well. In hierarchical societies, people cannot make important spiritual decisions without the approval of their leaders, so anyone who wants to reach them for Christ must go through their existing leaders. Christian international businessmen may be bridges of blessing into this people group. Pray that many family leaders from this people group will understand that their people are sinful just like the Israelis, and that they need to seek the Lord for forgiveness.
- * 2025 World Watch List (most dangerous countries for Christians) #21 Morocco: Please pray that God will help the Moroccan church be salt and light. Pray that Christians will be wise and courageous as they live for Jesus and work out how to share their faith. Pray that converts facing pressure from their families and communities will find hope and peace.
