#### VILLAGE MISSION'S FAMILY



Fred & Cindy Stromberg, Azalea, OR: Each year, thousands of people drive through Azalea without realizing it. The little white church they see from the freeway has been here since 1953, serving a community that was historically made up of timber industry workers and their families. In

recent times, it has become home to people who left bigger cities to live the country life. **PRAYER REQUESTS:** 1) Praise the Lord for ministry to those grieving the loss of a spouse and how we see people turning to Christ. 2) Although our community is generally older, we do have a growing group of young families. ### Pray for:

- \* Persecuted Christians <a href="www.persecution.com">www.persecution.com</a>- Nigeria: Aliyu Abubakar, 23, is a new Christian who has already suffered and escaped from persecution. He is a member of the Fulani, a nomadic people group across west and central Africa. Some Fulani groups are militant Muslims who attack Christian communities, and when Aliyu accepted Christ, he was locked in a room for days with little food to separate him from the friend who had brought him to Christ. He escaped by being smuggled from his village. Aliyu said he likes Psalm 23 because it encourages him to continue with his walk with God, knowing that God is his shepherd. He requests prayer for his family to come to know Christ and to receive him as their Lord and savior. He also asks for prayer that he will stay firm in his faith and live in peace with others.
- \* Unreached People <a href="https://joshuaproject.net/pray/unreachedoftheday/today-">https://joshuaproject.net/pray/unreachedoftheday/today-</a> Fuuta Torro in Guinea-Bissau: Most Pulaar Fulani live a rural life. They raise livestock, farm and fish. They live in small villages in round huts made of clay or rough bricks, with straw roofs. The Pulaar marry within their class divisions, women usually between the ages of 16 and 18, and men between the ages of 25 and 30. Although female genital mutilation is becoming increasingly illegal, over half of Pulaar girls from the ages of three to nine undergo ritual genital circumcision to be considered "clean" and worthy of marriage. The Pulaar (or Tukulor) are thought to have descended from the Fulani and the Wolof or Serere tribes. Pray for loving gospel workers to catch a vision for reaching the Pulaar Fulani and that in God's sovereign timing the hearts of these people would be open and ready to follow him. Pray for Jesus movements to bless extended families so the gospel will spread rapidly. Pray for the spiritual lives of the Pulaar Fulani to become fruitful so others will be drawn to Jesus Christ. Pray for Christ followers from other parts of West Africa to be Christ bearers to the Pulaar Fulani.
- \* 2025 World Watch List (most dangerous countries for Christians) #25 Uzbekistan: As the government continues to target Christians and churches for abuse, ask God to help them persevere and be witnesses to Christ's love. Pray that unregistered churches will not be targeted or harassed by authorities. Ask God to be with converts from Islam, who can experience pressure from their families and communities.
