- * Persecuted Christians www.persecution.com- Nigeria: A Christian widow has been unable to support herself and her children as Islamists regularly destroy her crops. Islamist groups regularly attack villages in central and northern parts of the country, and attacks against Christian communities are especially violent, leaving behind many widows. Victoria Luka, a mother of five, lost her husband to an attack on Sept. 17, 2018, near Jos. Their village was destroyed and their house burnt to ash. Victoria was able to escape to a neighboring village with her children. Victoria is a farmer but has been unable to sell her produce because Islamists continue to destroy her crops, and she is unable to farm elsewhere because she cannot buy fertilizer or seeds. Victoria asks that we pray for God's provision for her and her children. She also requests prayer for her children to follow Christ themselves.
- * Unreached People https://joshuaproject.net/pray/unreachedoftheday/today-Solanki Raiput in India: The name Raiput is derived from the Sanskrit word rajputra, meaning "son of a ruler." Rajputs were a class of South Asian warriors and nobles for centuries. At certain times, they were the warriors who conquered kingdoms and defended the land; when possible, they enjoyed the life of nobles. When the British Empire began controlling parts of the Subcontinent starting in the late 1700s, they recruited Rajputs into their military. In the early 1970s, Indian Prime Minister Indiaa Gandhi abolished the titles and property rights enjoyed by Rajputs. Solanki Rajputs have a strong sense of pride in their historical exploits. Even today they enjoy high status which reinforces that pride. Rajputs will need to overcome this spiritual obstacle and accept the Kingdom of God like small children if they are going to enter it. Pray for Christ's ambassadors to be careful to speak only what God tells them to say when they go to the nations. Pray the Lord will give Hindu Solanki Rajputs a spiritual hunger, then satisfy that hunger. Pray that these Rajputs will understand the value of becoming part of God's royal family. Pray for a humility for all Rajput communities to fall at the feet of the King of kings. Pray for a movement to Christ among every Rajput community.
- * 2025 World Watch List (most dangerous countries for Christians) #32 Oman: Please pray for church communities, that God will protect them. Ask that immigrant believers will have wisdom and boldness in living out their faith. Pray for Open Doors partners on the Arabian Peninsula to shine the light of Christ.
