* **Persecuted Christians** - www.persecution.com- **India:** Villagers in Chhattisgarh state reacted violently against local Christians who buried a non-Christian man on their property. The burial of Chamru Ram Salam on Dec. 16, 2025, was conducted according to the rites of a traditional tribal religion. However, because half of Salam's family, including three of his five sons, are Christian, the mob called the burial an insult to their deities. More than 500 villagers with wooden sticks and slingshots attacked mourners at the grave. Several people were injured, and the family and other Christians fled the village for weeks. The mob looted the family's property, set fire to their home and three churches and vandalized the homes of 15 other Christian families. Ultimately, local officials moved the body to a Christian cemetery, even though Salam's oldest son said that neither he nor his father were Christians. Pray for the safety and provision of this family and other local Christians.

Lolak: The Lolak homeland is fertile with long black sand beaches, flat grassy fields, coconut plantations, and rugged inland mountains. The Lolak are farmers who grow rice, coconuts, corn, cacao, and large, healthy cattle. They have developed primarily along the fringes of multiple powerful neighboring groups. They live in the Lolak district in the northeastern portion of Sulawesi Island in Indonesia. The Lolak are Sunni Muslims. They interweave traditional beliefs with Islamic teachings with hopes of earning a place in paradise. Opening new fields of employment is one of the greatest needs of the Lolak. A Lolak person who graduates from a university often finds it challenging to gain employment in their field of study, so they frequently return to farming. The Lolak intentionally reside in remote areas. Access to this group can be difficult. May this be the attitude of many from today's people group. Pray for increased economic development in Lolak villages. Pray that the Lolak would open their hearts and minds to the Lord Jesus. Pray that the Lord would use Jesus followers near the Lolak to reach out to their Muslim neighbors. Pray for the Lolak to seek spiritual answers that will be found only in Jesus Christ, regardless of community pressures.

* **2026 World Watch List** (most dangerous countries for Christians) #12 - **Saudi Arabia:** Pray that believers here will find a place to worship and grow in their knowledge of the Lord. Pray for immigrant Christians who meet secretly to receive God's protection and wisdom. Pray for God to bless all those who reach out to share the gospel in Saudi Arabia.
